Discussions with Rusty Clark (Pleasant Ridge School District Superintendent) have been positive. He has offered us a very generous amount of real estate for park development.

We have started to develop our grant plan with pursuit of \$3.5 million to develop a park on the grounds of Cottage Hill and Magnolia school.
